This accessory has an expected service life of five years.






Installation of harness, lower shell






Predrilled mounting holes.






If the existing holes are not suitable, you can drill a maximum of two holes in each blue area.






Installation of shoulder harness, upper shell



Installation of Ankle Huggers®


